HORSE SHOW RULES & GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

It is important to read our Show Terms & Conditions before submitting your entries

GENERAL CONDITIONS -

**** NATIONAL ENTRIES ****

All national entries must be submitted on the Mullingar online entry system by Monday 20 May. Owners / Riders have the facility to adjust /update all entries up to 10.00 am on Monday 27 May. Entries must be paid in full on or before 27 May. Entries are provisional until payment has been made, and are only confirmed on receipt of payment. When payment has been made entries will be deemed final.

**** WITHDRAWALS AND CANCELLATIONS ****

€10.00 of the entry fee is non refundable on each entry. If a horse/pony does not jump, the balance of the entry fee will be refunded after the show PROVIDED THE HORSE/PONY HAS BEEN WITHDRAWN at the latest half an hour before the commencement of the class.

LATE ENTRIES will only be accepted subject to availability and will incur a 20% Late Fee.

**** INTERNATIONAL ENTRIES ****

Both HORSE AND RIDER MUST BE REGISTERED with FEI in advance of the show. For Irish riders, please contact Susann in the Horse Sport Ireland office - skillilea@horsesportireland.ie - before 15 May to allow time for processing. Application forms can be downloaded from the [HSI website](#). International entries are payable in full by Monday 27 May. Declarations for international classes are taken at the show office up to 5.00 pm the evening before for the following day's classes.

**** DECLARATIONS FOR NATIONAL CLASSES ****

SJI Jumping Tickets must be submitted to the show office **no later than 30 minutes** before the scheduled class start time (or 30 minutes after for the first class of the day). Tickets will not be accepted after the class has started.

TICKETS FOR ALL FINALS MUST BE SUBMITTED BY 6.00 PM THE EVENING BEFORE for the next day's finals. Tickets not received will be withdrawn from the startlist. If you are not jumping, please come to the office to withdraw in order for the startlist to be updated. There will be no refunds given on tickets not withdrawn.

**** INTERNATIONAL HORSE CLASSES ****

Block entry fee of €375 for Silver Tour and €400 for Gold Tour (plus medical fee & manure disposal fee, €50 additional). Please read the [FEI Draft Schedule](#) for International Classes Rules and Regulations.

DECLARATIONS

All declarations for the International Classes must lodged with the secretary's office before **5.00 pm on the evening prior** to the class.

**** PUISSANCE ****

Prizefund €4,000 – **Horse & Rider must be registered with Show Jumping Ireland** before the show. This class is pre entry as per national class rules.

SUNDRY

- Show Organisers and Directors reserve the right to reject or refuse any entry or to alter the schedule.
- Times or Arenas are subject to change.
- The organisers will not be responsible for any accident or damage to persons, vehicles or property.
- By the receipt of your entry, Mullingar International Horse Show understands that you acknowledge that you have read all the conditions and accept the same unreservedly, and understand that consent to participation in the event is only on the basis of the above conditions.
- Competitors are responsible for their own errors and those of their agents in the preparation of their entry forms and completion of online forms. The Organising Committee do not take any responsibility for errors.

PROPERTY

Show Organisers are not responsible for the theft of any property or tack during the show. It is competitors' responsibility to ensure that all tack/property are kept in a safe place.

COMPETITION RULES

The Mullingar International Horse Show will run under the SJI National Competition and FEI Rules

COMPETITION PRIZE GIVING CEREMONIES

Winners of championships and / or other awards must be present for the Award Presentations. Competitors who do not comply will forfeit their prizes.

BRIDLE NUMBERS

Bridle Numbers must be worn by horses in the International Section at all times when outside of their assigned stable. The use of a wrong number or having no number may result in disqualification from the competition.

HEALTH & SAFETY

It is the riders' responsibility to familiarise themselves with both the FEI & SJI Health & Safety and Horse Welfare regulations. Riders must co-operate with all FEI & SJI Stewards, Starters and all other Show Officials .

Only riders entered in the specific competition and their coach or trainer may walk the course.

No Dogs are permitted in the Arena. Dogs must be kept on a lead in all other areas on the showgrounds.

It is compulsory for anyone mounted on a horse on the competition grounds to wear a properly fastened hard hat, with a three point retention harness. Senior Riders may remove their headgear for ceremonial protocol in the competition arena only. (FEI Art 256.1.4)

PRIZEMONEY

All prize money will be paid in Euros. National Prizemoney paid at the show is by cheque or cash, and it is important that the winning rider attends the presentation. International Prize money and some National Finals' Prizemoney will be paid after the show (in 14 - 21 days) & will be drawn to the order of the account holder's name and address as indicated on the online entry form.

**** NATIONAL STABLES & PRIORITY PARKING ****

Stables are bookable separately on <https://entry.equipe.com/meetings/162> before 20 May (Note these usually sell out in advance). Stabling must be booked and paid for in advance. International entry fees include a stable.

CANCELLATIONS

Stabling cancellations must be made in writing before Monday 20 May. No refunds after this deadline.

ARRIVAL & OPENING HOURS

The showgrounds will be open from **2.00 pm on Thursday 30 May**. On arrival please check in with our Stable Manager before unloading horses/ ponies .

Make sure you have your passport available at all times if requested by a show official .

GATES CLOSE nightly at 21.00 SHARP

ALLOCATION OF STABLING

The Stable Manager will do their utmost to accommodate all stabling requests but depending on the quantities and demand this may not always be possible.

Due to increased FEI security requirements, FEI horses will not be stabled with National level horses.

All horses entering the FEI stabling area must provide proof of a current Equine Influenza vaccination as per FEI regulations.

Please do not block aisles or stable doors with decorations or tack trunks. Do not structurally alter stables in any way or write on/deface stables.

Under no circumstances may a horse be placed in a stable to which it has not been assigned. Competitors must not move from their assigned block of stables without the permission of the Show Office.

NB - Owners of **stallions** must ensure that they bring an **electric fence** with them. The show will not take any responsibility for stallions that do not have an electric fence around their stable.

Please ensure that your horse/pony has **up to date vaccinations**.

Scooters, Quads and all **MPVs** are strictly prohibited and will be confiscated!

DRESS CODE

The dress code must be in accordance with FEI Rules. Riders are required to wear numbers as provided.

INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOUR

In the interest of the horse, any behaviour deemed to be inappropriate / cruel will be acted upon.

DATA PROTECTION

Mullingar International Horse Show takes privacy seriously and will only use your personal information for the purpose of processing entries and stable bookings, publishing start lists and results and for post-show finances (invoices and/or distribution of prize money). Entry and result information for Mullingar International Horse Show is processed by our appointed data handler, Equipe AB and by Show Jumping Ireland and the FEI. Your information will not be shared with other parties or individuals without your permission.
