

COVID 19 PROTOCOLS FOR RIDERS & THEIR TEAM when visiting Mullingar EC for Schooling / Training & Shows 2020



1. Familiarise yourself with all HSE Covid 19 guidelines. Do not travel if you or any of your team are **feeling unwell** or have been abroad in the previous 14 days
2. **ALL EQUESTRIAN ACTIVITIES** (Schooling, Training or Shows) **MUST BE PRE BOOKED ONLINE** (by 6.00 pm the day before, this may vary) **on the Venue's Web Site**. For Mullingar EC visit www.mullingarequestrian.com . It is in all our interests that correct booking procedures are followed and all required information is submitted.
3. Please **read the ECOVA Covid 19 Guidelines & watch the short video** on our web site as per booking instructions (this must be done by all team members travelling)
4. Before leaving home - pack an additional supply of hygiene products for your own personnel use. Only the necessary team members may travel. No spectators, non riders, small children, pets, etc. Make sure you save a copy of your booking on your phone (or print a copy)
5. On arrival - park in a designated parking space. There must be at least 5 metres between each vehicle. **SEND A TEXT TO ROBERT TO LET HIM KNOW THAT YOU HAVE ARRIVED.**
6. Before taking down horses - please wash hands at a designated area.
7. **SOCIAL DISTANCING** of 2 metres must be adhered to at all times. Avoid unnecessary touching of arena surround fences, doors, gates, etc. where possible.
8. Once horses are tacked up, follow the designated route to the warm up arena.
9. Max 4 (6 in phase 2) horses in practice arenas and if sharing fences use hygiene products provided.
10. When finished jumping, proceed to the designated warm down arena.
11. After using the wash bay clean down all hoses & pipes.
12. Avoid using bathrooms only as necessary.
13. Keep to you own group & respect all staff and any other riders that you may meet when you visit the premises by adhering to the 2 metre social distance rule.
14. Leave the arena as you found it & remember to adhere to all Safety Procedures. Approved helmets must be worn at all times & back protectors are recommended.
15. Each venue will have trained Compliance Officer. You are asked to co-operate with any instructions or advice that may be offered.

We look forward to welcoming your team back to Mullingar for schooling and training and, hopefully, in the weeks ahead, we will get the opportunity to return to shows. If we can do anything to help with your visit please ask.
